**Adults:** We invite parents to join us at meetings and outings. As with any organization, the more you are involved the more your scout will succeed. While on campouts and outings, we expect scouts to follow direction from the troop's youth leadership and not their parents. Parents and scouts are not allowed to share tents.

**Youth:** We are a youth-led troop to provide our scouts with true, authentic leadership experiences. Our meetings and outings may not run the most efficiently but that is not the point. We want our scouts to have a safe place to learn from opportunities they experience.
